Whitney Portal Store, end of the Whitney Portal Road off Hwy 395 from Lone Pine, CA.

MEETING TIME

8:00am

ACCOMODATIONS/CAMPING before or after the climb:

Nearby motel accommodations are available in Lone Pine, California. We recommend sleeping at higher elevation prior to the climb to aid in the acclimatization process. There is a campground at Whitney Portal, though this campground is often full and sites are difficult to acquire.

The best solution is a walk-in campsite reserved for those with a Wilderness Permit (provided by ASI) to begin climbing the following day. Bring a headlamp, sleeping bag, pad, light tent (such as a Black Diamond® First Light) in case it rains.
